



## **GDPR OVERVIEW**

On May 25, 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) went into effect as the primary law regulating how companies protect EU citizens' personal data. In addition to EU members, it is important to note that **ANY** company that markets goods or services to EU residents, **REGARDLESS** of its location, is subject to the regulation. As a result, GDPR will have an impact on data requirements in the United States. All organizations, including small to medium-sized companies and large enterprises, must be aware of all GDPR requirements and should now be compliant. GoldSky security assessors can assist in the process of achieving GDPR compliance.

## **METHODOLOGY**

The GoldSky GDPR Assessment focuses on the specific requirements of the EU-GDPR Security Requirements which **will include**:

- Interviews with key personnel in core functional areas and information technology;
- Review of documentation to support EU-GDPR compliance;
- Testing of identified EU-GDPR controls;
- Identification of gaps in the Organization's compliance with the EU-GDPR;
- A detailed Remediation Roadmap with recommendations to assist in closing GDPR gaps.

The GDPR itself contains 11 chapters and 91 articles. Some of the key privacy and data protection requirements of the **GDPR include:** 

- Requiring the consent of subjects for data processing;
- Analyzing collected data to protect privacy;
- Providing data breach notifications;
- Safely handling the transfer of data across borders:
- Requiring certain companies to appoint a data protection officer to oversee GDPR compliance.

Simply put, the GDPR mandates a baseline set of standards for companies that handle EU citizens' data to better safeguard the processing and movement of citizens' personal data.
